What You Must Bring To Get Your Taxes Done

- Your Social Security Card and Cards for all claimed dependents* (*Originals Only*)
- Valid Picture ID (Driver's License or State ID)
- Proof of Income
 - Wages (all Forms W-2)
 - Unemployment (Form 1099-G)
 - Gambling/Lottery Winnings (Form W-2G)
 - Miscellaneous Income (Form 1099-Misc)
 - Pension (Form 1099-R)
 - Social Security Benefit (Form 1099-SSA)
 - Supplemental Security Income (Form 1099-SSI/Form 1099-SSD), Letter from SSA
 - Social Security Disability (1099-SSDA)
 - VA total monthly benefit or sum for the year from the Dept. of Veterans Affairs
 - Interest and Dividends (Form 1099-INT and/or 1099-DIV)
 - DHS Assistance (DHS Annual Statement)
 - Other relevant information about income
- Proof of Expenses
 - Total amount of residential electric/heating costs paid in 2011.
 - Energy Efficiency Home Appliances and Improvements (*receipts should show Energy Star rating*); *insulation; windows, furnace; water heater; refrigerator; clothes washer, dishwasher*
 - *Medical or HMO Premiums paid for self and/or family dependants*
 - Total amount paid for day care and the day care provider's tax identification number (the individual's Social Security #)
 - Student Loan Interest, Tuition and course materials.
- Homeowners
 - Proof of taxable value of your home and bills of summer/winter property taxes paid in 2011.
 - Mortgage Interest (Form 1098)
- Renters
 - Lease or rental contract and rent receipts for 2011.
 - Landlord's name, address & zip codes.
- For Direct Deposit*
 - Bank or Credit Union name, routing number and account numbers.
- Other Relevant Information
 - Copy of last year federal and state tax returns.
