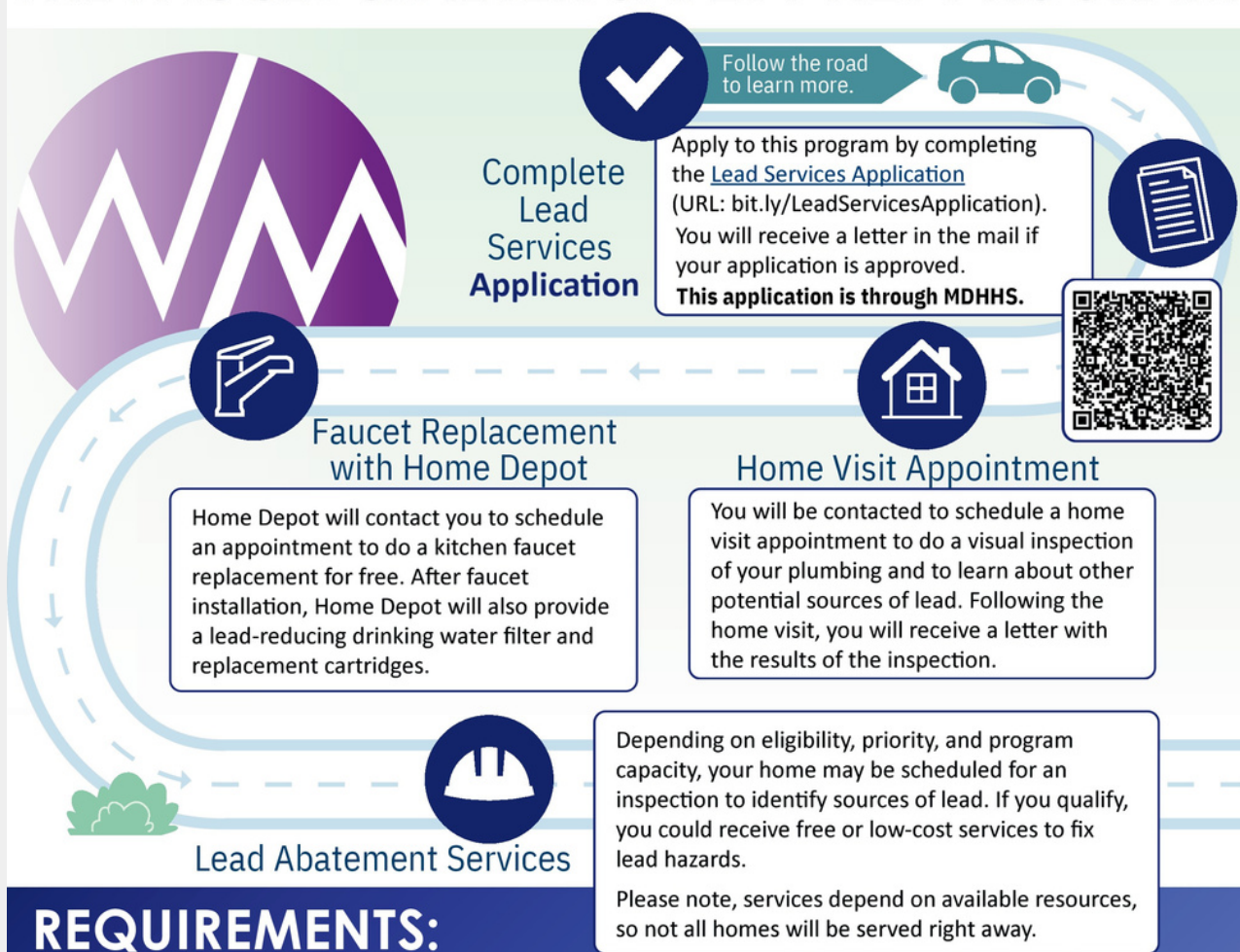
The Community Engagement Team had the pleasure to attend these events. where they reflected the mission of our organization, showcased our programs, and aid a resource to our community.

## THE FAUCET & FILTER SAFETY NET PROGRAM



### REQUIREMENTS:

- 1) The home must be occupied by a child under 19 years of age and/or a pregnant person enrolled in Medicaid.
- 2) The home has, or unsure if it has, one of the following:
  - Lead or galvanized plumbing.
  - A lead service line carries water from the street to the home.
  - Old faucets and fittings that were sold before 2014.
- 3) The home must be located in one of the following communities:
  - City of Ecorse • City of Hamtramck • City of Highland Park
- 4) MDHHS will contact client upon an approved application.
- 5) WM can help assist with the application, and if any inquiries or follow-ups are needed, please contact us at our email listed below.
