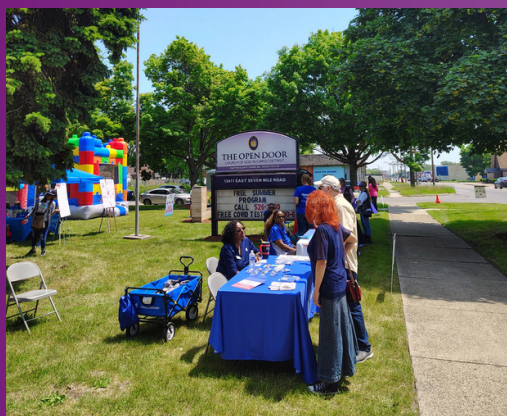
COUNCILMAN BENSON CLERGY RESOURCE BRUNCH

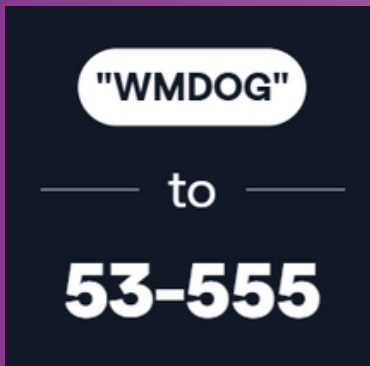
