

HOW TO APPLY FOR THE STELLANTIS IMPACT NEIGHBORHOOD FUND

WHAT IS THE STELLANTIS IMPACT NEIGHBORHOOD FUND?

Part of the [Neighborhood Beautification Program](#), the **Stellantis Impact Neighborhood Fund** provides funds to neighborhood associations, block clubs, nonprofits, and faith-based groups to improve the quality of life in the [Stellantis Community Benefits \(CBO\) Impact Area](#).

Grants between \$5,000 and \$10,000 are available for projects that respond to and advance the recommendations of the [Greater Warren/Conner Neighborhood Framework](#). Both the applicant organization and proposed project must be located in the [Stellantis CBO Impact Area](#), within City Council District 4 on the far east side of Detroit.

STEP 1 APPLICANT ELIGIBILITY

- Must be registered as a block club with the Department of Neighborhoods or partnered with a City-registered block club (see [Partnership Letter](#)).
- Block clubs must be a 501(c)(3) or an LLC with a 501(c)(3) fiduciary.
- Non-profits applying in partnership with a block club must be a 501(c)(3).
- Must be located in the [CBO Impact Area](#).

STEP 3 DESIGN YOUR PROJECT

Stellantis Impact Neighborhood Fund grants may be used towards two types of projects:

Beautification projects such as:

- Community gardens, public space improvements, or clean-up activities

Community programming in topics such as:

- Gardening, health/fitness, life skills, or community safety & awareness

STEP 2 SELECT YOUR SITE

- Beautification projects must have a deed in the organization's name for a location in the [CBO Impact Area](#).
- Community programming projects must have a deed or lease for a program site in a location in the [CBO Impact Area](#).
