Project Description: Wayne Metro's team will offer a Youth Summer Camp for residents in the Detroit, RAC 2 community (48202). Our goal is to provide a fun and safe environment for youth to attend while parents are away at work during the summer hours. After talking with parents across our community it became clear that many must leave their children under 10 home alone as they cannot afford childcare and have to go to work. This program will target youth ages 8-10. Our courses offered include Science and Technology, Sports and General Fitness, Art and Detroit History. Two specialized instructors will come in to teach the Sports and General Fitness and the Science course. Participants will gain skills across many fields while building their communication with their peers. The program will operate 4 days a week Monday-Thursday from 11:00am-3:00pm. The camp will run July 1st, 2026- July 30th, 2026. We will take participants to four field trips (once a week) located at the Detroit Institute of Arts, The Science Center, The Charles H Wright Museum and a Pistons Game. Breakfast, Lunch and an end of day snack will be provided for every participant. We will purchase the program supplies of food at Meijer and volunteers will prepare it in our kitchen to serve in the cafeteria. At the end of the program each participant will receive a completion certificate and medal of achievement.

Three Project Activities:

1. Our courses offered include Science and Technology, Sports and General Fitness, Art and Detroit History
2. We will take participants to four field trips (once a week) located at the Detroit.

Institute of Arts, The Science Center, The Charles H Wright Museum and a Pistons Game.

3. Build communication skills with their peers.
